Provides services to the civil nuclear industry to deliver a sustainable source of electricity for consumers around the world



Challenge

- No standardised view of risk
- Difficult to aggregate information risk at an enterprise level
- Required to demonstrate the rigour of assessments and accuracy of the information risk reports



Solution

- Attending **IRAM₂** training workshops provided greater clarity of the concepts and definitions
- Transitioning to a single approach led to a more consistent understanding of the risk landscape
- Satisfied the requirements of the risk owners and regulators. The organisation now has a 'cyber risk' category in the global risk register



Member recommendations

- Approve a consistent set of information asset categories to help streamline the deployment of **IRAM₂** across the enterprise
- Identify the 'roles' to support each phase of **IRAM₂** and confirm their availability to participate in the process prior to conducting the information risk assessments
- Follow the step-by-step approach in a methodical manner and keep the training material at hand to act as a quick reference guide when required
